Committee Reports:

ARPA Committee Report:

No new developments to report.

Finance Committee Report:

Council Members, Greg Smith and Teresa Tilson, had no new items to report. They announced that work on the Budget for FY2023-2024 will begin soon. They also reported that the Town is waiting for responses from the RFP for Audit services. At this time, only one response has been received.

Maintenance Committee Report:

Derek Pearcy updated that one bid has been received regarding the new Heating/Cooling units for the WCFD located on Roland Street, and that two additional companies (Boones Heating and Air, LLC and Gilliams Heating and Cooling) have expressed interest and are working on their bids.

Personnel Committee Report:

Gave a warm welcome back to Rhonda Neeley, Office Manager who returned to the Town on April 3rd. Other items will be discussed in Closed Session.

Planning Committee Report:

No new developments to report at this time, just a reminder that zoning needs to be addressed soon.

Street Committee Report:

Zackary Salyer, Committee Member, gave an update that several potholes have been repaired by VDOT on Chapel Street that were large enough to cause vehicle damage. The committee is gathering bids and information regarding the street and drainage problem repair on Maple Street (a Town owned road). They have also contacted VDOT about additional NO Parking and Speed Limit signage required on Johnson Street addressing the parking and speed problems that citizens are having there.

Police Department Report:

Chief Donald Harding, III, presented the Council with a brief summary of recent Police Department events. He shared with the Council that new hire, Matt Bledsoe is doing well in his 2nd week of the Academy. Some attendees have quit already, so please keep Matt in your prayers to succeed. Chief Harding made the request to the Council again, to approve the purchase of 2 new police vehicles through ARPA funds. He has received 2 quotes from Architectural firms for the cost of designing the renovation of the Police Department. He introduced to the Council the COPS Grant and what it entails. He also informed the Council that several people have expressed an interest in donating towards the purchase of a K9 officer, and the Department plans to initiate a fundraiser for that purchase/program.

Fire Department Report:

Bruce Cross, gave the report for the WCVFD. He thanked members of the Council who have stopped by the Fire Department to see the progress being made there. Then he inquired of the money due the Fire Department from the Scott County Administrator's Office, who gave the WCVFD permission to use the surplus funds (\$9,801.41) from the equipment purchase of February 2021.

Lola Dean then spoke on behalf of the WCVFD, requesting the Town to support the good work they do.
